BY-LAW NUMBER 056-2015

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NUMBER 049-2012 BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE SECOND-HAND GOODS, SALVAGE AND OLD GOLD IN THE TOWN OF COBOURG

WHEREAS pursuant to provisions of section 11 (2) (6) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S. O. c. 25 as amended provides that a municipality may pass by-laws respecting the health, safety and well-being of persons;


AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 150 and 151 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, a municipality may provide for a system of licences with respect to any business wholly or partly carried on within the municipality, including the sale or hire of goods or services on an intermittent or one time basis;

1. THAT **Section 1** of By-law No.049-2012 be amended to replace and include the the following definition of a second-hand dealer.

“Second-Hand Dealer” shall mean a person who carries on the business of buying, selling, taking in trade, procuring, offering for sale or accepting in pawn second-hand property, or who operates a second-hand dealer’s premises, and this includes any person who travels from place to place to sell second-hand goods, as a Second-Hand dealer.

This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon the date of its passing.

READ a first, second and third time and finally passed in Open Council this 29th day of June, 2015.
