

**A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH THE FEDERATION OF CANADIAN MUNICIPALITIES AND THE TOWN OF COBOURG FOR THE GREEN MUNICIPAL FUND FOR THE GREEN ENERGY RETROFIT (GER) FEASIBILITY STUDY PROJECT**


**WHEREAS** pursuant to Section 9 of the *Municipal Act, S.O. 2001* which provides in part that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

**AND WHEREAS** the Cobourg Municipal Council has expressed a desire to enter into an agreement with the Federation of Canadian Municipalities in order to continue to advance the work on the Green Energy Retrofit (GER) Feasibility Study (running concurrently with the Integrated Community Sustainability Plan (ICSP) and the Green Development Standards (GDS) project) by fulfilling the following objectives of the 2019-2022 Strategic Plan.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Cobourg enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the Mayor and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized and instructed to execute on behalf of the Corporation an authorization of an agreement with the Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) to receive funding as part of the Town of Cobourg's Green Energy Retrofit Feasibility Study (running concurrently with the Integrated Community Sustainability Plan and the Green Development Standards project).
2. **THAT** this by-law shall come into full force on the day it is passed.
