## Book Blanket "Instructions"

This project is similar to the fairly well known Temperature Blanket. Except, with this version your colours correspond to the genre of book you have read. As with a Temperature blanket, there are no set rules, colours or pattern required to make your project. This project is $100 \%$ flexible and can be changed to suit your own wants and needs. Below is a basic example on how you would plan your very own Book Blanket. $100-200$ pages $=5$ rows (2) $401-500$ pages $=20$ rows
$201-300$ pages $=10$ rows $(3)$
$500+$ pages $=25$ rows (6)
$301-400$ pages $=15$ rows (4)
Book separation = 1 row
(If you wish to do a smaller project like a shawl or scarf decrease the number of rows per page count. I will put in brackets what I used for my own shawl.)

Genres and colours are just a suggestion. Feel free to use your favorite genres and colours.

| Genre | Colour |
| :--- | :--- |
| Romance | Pink |
| Fantasy | Purple |
| Paranormal | Grey |
| Horror | Red |
| Science fiction | Yellow |
| Thriller | Orange |
| Non-fiction | Blue |
| Separation row | Black or White |

Suggestion: if you read mostly non-fiction, feel free to divide the non-fiction section into multiple genres/colours.
